In October of 2021, we started preparation of our site at 202 Dairyland Rd, next to River View Park.

In partnership with the City of Buellton, we plan to open Phase 1 of our site in 2025.

- **Phase 1:** Develop the upper portion of our site including our art/science maker space, picnic area, mud kitchen, sensory garden, and truck zone.
- **Phase 2:** Develop the lower portion the land including the play houses, hillside slides, climbing area and tunnels.
